

Ireka clinches Iskandar deal

KUALA LUMPUR: Ireka Corporation Bhd has received a RM268.6 million contract from UEM Land Bhd for the construction of an integrated waterfront and marina development in Nusajaya, Iskandar Johor. Its unit, Ireka Engineering & Construction Sdn Bhd, will build a 35-storey, 246-unit serviced apartments and a 16-storey office tower with retail space, car parks and recreational facilities. The project will commence in August this year, and

is expected to be completed in 24 months. This contract will bring Ireka's current order book to about RM1.6 billion, of which approximately RM500 million remains outstanding. Ireka's current construction order book includes the 330-bed City International Hospital in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam, the Harbour Mall Sandakan and the Four Points by Sheraton Sandakan hotel in Sabah as well as two office towers and the Aloft Hotel in KL Sentral.
