Ireka bags RM163m job in Cyberjaya

PETALING JAVA: Ireka Corp Bhd has won a RM163 million contract from OSK Property Holdings Bhd to build serviced apartments for the second phase of the Pan'gaea Solstice mixed-development project in Cyberjaya.

Ireka, via its unit Ireka Engineering & Construction Sdn Bhd, yesterday received a letter of acceptance from OSK Property's unit Wawasan Rajawali Sdn Bhd for the project.

The scope of works entails the construction

of a 39-storey and 35-storey serviced apartment blocks, comprising car-parks, roof garden, facilities and swimming pool and 946 units of SOHO serviced apartments.

The project is expected to complete in 28

months, beginning March 29, 2013. In a statement yesterday, Ireka said the

contract brings the group's order book to about RM860 million, of which RM640 million remains outstanding.
