

Four Points by Sheraton hotel opens doors in Sandakan

PETALING JAYA (May 30, 2012): A Four Points by Sheraton hotel opened its doors for a soft launch today in Sandakan, Sabah -- the first international brand hotel in that city.

The hotel is part of an integrated commercial development called Sandakan Harbour Square, which is being developed by ICSD Ventures Sdn Bhd -- a unit of London-listed Aseana Properties Ltd, together with the Sandakan Municipal Council. Ireka Corp Bhd is the development manager.

Targeting business travellers, the 300-room Four Points by Sheraton offers a ballroom and meeting rooms totaling close to 1,600 sq m. It also features a gym and a swimming pool.

Situated in the new central business district, Sandakan Harbour Square consists of Four Points by Sheraton Sandakan, a Central Market (market and fish jetty), town square and waterfront esplanade for community events, commercial shop offices, as well as a five-level shopping mall.
